A very warm welcome to the Lendvai String Trio's second newsletter! February has been an intensely focussed month for us with a five day, double cd recording project of all five Beethoven string trios at a very wintry Potton Hall in Suffolk, England - our first major project to be funded by the Kersjes Prize, and neatly timed to coincide with the anniversary of our first ever concert together as a trio eight years ago in which we performed Beethoven's string trio Op.8.

We were extremely privileged to have producer John Fraser and sound engineer Arne Akselberg on board for the project. They are a fantastic team, and it was a great pleasure and honour to work with them. Beethoven's trios have been a constant for us during these eight years; the many, many hours we have happily spent, first discovering and performing each of them for the first time, to the microscopically detailed discussions (and sometimes arguments!) over each phrase, note and harmony that continue to slowly change and grow, even now. To have recorded all five trios feels like we have passed a milestone; one that points to the onward journey as well as telling us how far we have travelled.

The cd is planned to be released on Stone Records in late Autumn. We will keep you updated!
